## Church Attendance Agreement for Congregational Tuition Support

As a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church we ask that you indicate your support for the church and school and your commitment to your chosen church family by placing your initials before the following statements:

- \_\_\_\_\_ a) We will support St. Paul's Lutheran Church and School with our Christian example and participation in its programs and activities.
- \_\_\_\_\_ b) We will be good stewards by paying our tuition on time and by contributing regularly to the church's financial needs.
- \_\_\_\_\_ c) We will pray regularly for the church and school, and use our time and talents for the work of the church and school.
- \_\_\_\_\_ d) We will make it a priority to attend all church and school activities to support our child(ren) and the church family we have chosen.

As a member of St. Paul's Lutheran Church you are entitled to enroll your child at the member tuition rates.

These rates are as follows:

- 1 child = \$2200 annually
- 2 children = \$4100 annually
- 3 children = \$4650 annually
- There is no additional tuition charged beyond the third child.

***Please read the following carefully.***

St. Paul's Lutheran Church and its governing boards has mandated that in order to be eligible for the member tuition rate you must attend 60% of weekend church services at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Bourbonnais. If church attendance falls below the 60% requirements for either semester, you will be placed on a nonmember status for purpose of school tuition only for the next semester. The 60% constitutes attending a minimum of 12 church services each semester. Church attendance will be evaluated by the Day School Board in December and again in April. You will be able to restore your member tuition status for the following semester by attending 60% of weekend church services during the semester for which it was suspended. Finally, it is also understood that 60% weekend attendance is required to receive financial assistance from the church. Financial assistance is available to members who show a financial need.

Your weekend church attendance is recorded only if you sign the attendance cards located at the end of each pew. In order to receive member tuition rates you must sign your name below indicating you have read and understood the above statements.
